PragueCenter) or Hotel Villa Mansland (www.villa-mansland.eu) - a gay - owned hotel run by two gentlemen of German descent. There are 15 hotel rooms and comfortable apartments and suites with TVs, phones, and mini-bars and WI-FI connection.
